We aim to achieve the highest possible standards of performance across a broad range of repertoire and musical styles, whilst at the same time seeking to entertain our audiences whatever their background.

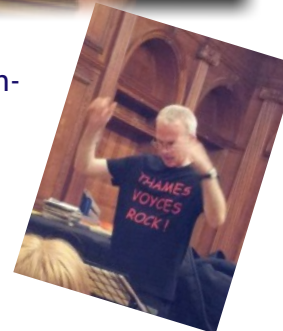
